The Chemeketa Cooperative Regional Library Service [CCRLS] Advisory Council is accepting applications for Rural Lay Representative. This can be anyone from the CCRLS district who lives outside of member library cities or districts. The CCRLS Council makes recommendations for regional library policies and services. Commitments are for 5 to 6 meetings between September and May, for a 3 year term.

CCRLS was begun in 1974 as an innovative project to demonstrate library resource and information sharing in the four-county area, Marion, Polk, Yamhill and parts of Linn Counties. Presently CCRLS has 17 member libraries: Amity, Dallas, Dayton, Independence, Jefferson, Lyons, McMinnville, Monmouth, Mount Angel, Newberg, Salem, Sheridan, Silver Falls Library District, Stayton, Willamina, and Woodburn, as well as Chemeketa Community College Library. The system has about 1,200,000 books, electronic, and audio-visual materials, annual circulation of about 3,000,000, and serves about 500,000 people.
